On behalf of the Operating Committee, it is my pleasure to invite you to participate as a sponsor/exhibitor at the 2025 American Control Conference (ACC'25), to be held at the Sheraton Denver Downtown Hotel in Denver, CO, July 8-10, 2025. ACC is the main control conference in North America, featuring more than 1,000 presentations from both academia and industry. As such, it offers considerable opportunities for recruiting top-caliber students, showcasing cutting-edge products and research, and establishing collaborations with researchers and engineers.

There are five levels of sponsorship for ACC'25: Diamond (\$20,000), Emerald (\$15,000), Gold (\$7,000), Silver (\$5,000), and Bronze (\$2,500).

Gold Sponsors will have their company name, logo, and a brief description displayed prominently on the conference website and in the printed conference program, will receive two complimentary conference registrations, can include a brochure insert in the conference registration packet, and can select to showcase their products and/or technology in a dedicated exhibit booth, or receive one additional complimentary conference registration. Gold Sponsors can also propose a Special Session on a topic of their choosing (that is relevant to the conference).

Silver Sponsors will have their company name, logo, and a brief description displayed on the conference website and in the printed conference program, will receive one complimentary conference registration, can include a brochure insert in the conference registration packet, and can select to showcase their products and/or technology in a dedicated exhibit booth, or receive one additional, complimentary conference registration.

Bronze Sponsors will have their company name, logo, and a brief description displayed on the conference website and in the printed conference program.

For 2025, the AACC has added the Diamond and Emerald sponsorship levels. Emerald sponsors will have the same benefits as Gold sponsors plus the addition of: one free conference workshop, sponsorship of a social event, two invitations to the VIP reception, and a total of four complimentary registrations. Diamond sponsors receive the same benefits as Emerald sponsors plus an additional conference exhibit booth, a total of four invitations to the VIP reception and five complimentary conference registrations.

In addition, there are opportunities to be a Reception Sponsor for major conference events, such as opening and closing receptions. A reception sponsor will have the event named after the company and enjoy the exclusive showcasing and recruiting opportunities at the event that is attended by almost all conference participants.
