
3) Click on "Submit your Abstract"






5) Select "Student Oral Presentation Award Nominations" and click Done.




6) Select "Oral" and click Done




7) Enter the title of your abstract. This should be the same title you used in your original abstract submission. This lets us link your original abstract and this application.




8) Select "Yes" to the question "Is this a student submission." Enter the authors on the abstract. Click Done.
