

Page Limit Formulas for Authors Publishing in AIP Advances

AIP Advances is a single column publication format, so word count is most appropriate for determining page length. The following are equivalent to 4 pages for contributed papers and 7 pages for invited papers.

MMM Contributed Article Manuscript Length (3500 words)

Word users

Manuscripts should not exceed approximately 3500 words. Abstract, title, author list, references and acknowledgments are all excluded from the 3500-word limit. Figures, tables, and equations, however, are included and must be accounted for by calculating the following word count equivalent to the space they occupy:

Highlight the manuscript text, excluding abstract, author list, acknowledgements and references, and note the word count at the bottom of the screen. Add to that the word-count-equivalents for figures, tables and equations as follows:

Figures: 400 words for an average figure.

Tables: 13 words per line, plus 26 words.

Equations: 13 words per line.

If the total number of words (text + figures + tables + equations) is 3500 or less, the length is acceptable.

TeX users

Authors are advised to use the [REVTeX 4.1 file](#). If the version of the manuscript obtained using the “reprint” option fits on four pages, the length is acceptable.

MMM Invited Article Manuscript Length (6000 words)

Word users

Manuscripts should not exceed approximately 6000 words. Abstract, title, author list, references and acknowledgments are all excluded from the 6000-word limit. Figures, tables, and equations, however, are included and must be accounted for by calculating the following word count equivalent to the space they occupy:

Highlight the manuscript text, excluding abstract, author list, acknowledgements and references, and note the word count at the bottom of the screen. Add to that the word-count-equivalents for figures, tables and equations as follows:

Figures: 400 words for an average figure.

Tables: 13 words per line, plus 26 words.

Equations: 13 words per line.

If the total number of words (text + figures + tables + equations) is 6000 or less, the length is acceptable.

TeX users

Authors are advised to use the [REVTeX 4.1 file](#). If the version of the manuscript obtained using the “reprint” option fits on seven pages, the length is acceptable.
